Who is the Holy Ghost?

- It's very difficult for us to understand as finite beings.
 - The body of Jesus is:
 - The limit of the unlimited
 - The visible of the invisible
 - The finite of the infinite.
- We have both a spirit and a body, but we are one person. God is a spirit (John 4:24). Jesus is simply the body of God manifested in the flesh, so He could walk among us as a man to fulfill His purpose (to rescue us).

Who is Jesus Christ?


- Jesus did things and said things specifically to fool those who don't want to know the truth!
- In Matt 13:10-11 The disciples asked why He taught only in parables
- His answer: It is given unto you to know the mysteries ... but to them it is not given.
- Matt 13:9 Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.
- Those who have ears to hear are those God wants to understand!

Who is Jesus Christ?

- Matt 13:13 Therefore speak I to them in parables: because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not, neither do they understand.
- 14 And in them is fulfilled the prophecy of Esaias, which saith, By hearing ye shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing ye shall see, and shall not perceive:
- Matt 15:8 This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me.

Who is Jesus Christ?

- Again, it's all about loving God...



Who is Jesus Christ?

- 2 Thess 2:10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 11 And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:
- It's sad to have to acknowledge this, but people who don't really love God with all their heart will find it impossible to understand the identity of Jesus, because God doesn't want them to...

Who is Jesus Christ?

- I'm going to discuss more about Jesus, but first let's look at a couple other things...
- How many Gods are there?
- Who is the Holy Ghost / Holy Spirit?
- What is the meaning of the "Trinity" or "Triune God"?
- I'm going into great detail on related content because this is so important for complete understanding!

Who is the Holy Ghost?

- *Luke 1:35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.*
- *Matt 1:18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.*

Who is the Holy Ghost?

- The Holy Ghost is the father of Jesus.
- So then who is “God the Father”? They are one and the same.
- In Acts, on the day of Pentecost, when the Holy Ghost was given, Peter tells the crowd that this was the prophecy from Joel, where God pours out His Spirit on all flesh.
- The Holy Spirit is simply the Spirit which is God the Father.

Who is the Holy Ghost?

- *Acts 2:16 But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; 17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh:*
- *Joel 2:28 And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh;*
- God is a Spirit. The Holy Ghost is that Spirit. It's that simple.
- *John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.*

Who is the Holy Ghost?

- In Genesis we also see that the Spirit of God (the Holy Ghost) is the Creator, the Father.
- *Gen 1:2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.*

Who is the Holy Ghost?

- I took the liberty of looking up the original Greek and Hebrew words for the words "spirit" and "ghost".
- In the New Testament, I found that the exact same Greek word is used where they have translated it into both Spirit and Ghost (IE: Holy Spirit and Holy Ghost).
- And the Hebrew word when used to speak of the Spirit of God in the Old Testament, as in Gen 1:2, has the same meaning as the Greek word used in the New Testament.
- This is positive proof that there is no difference and no separation of any kind, it is just simply the Spirit of God that is God the Father, and the Creator.

Who is the Holy Ghost?

- Jesus says that He will come as the comforter; the Holy Ghost. This can mean nothing other than that Jesus is also the Holy Ghost. Jesus is that one God!
- *John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; 17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. 18 I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.*

Who is the Holy Ghost?

- If the Spirit of God dwell in you, the Spirit of Christ is in you. The Spirit of Christ is the Holy Ghost.
- *Rom 8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. 10 And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.*

Who is the Holy Ghost?

- God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts. The spirit of the Son is the same spirit as the Holy Ghost. Jesus, God, the Holy Ghost, the Father, the Son are all one and the same.
- *Gal 4:6 And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.*

Who is the Holy Ghost?

- The prophets from the Old Testament prophesied of Christ by the Spirit of Christ. These words are all used interchangeably. The Spirit of God, the Holy Ghost, the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Christ are all simply the Spirit which is God.
- *1 Peter 1:10-12 Of which salvation the prophets have inquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you: 11 Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow. 12 Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.*

What is the Trinity?

- The Holy Spirit being the Spirit which is God makes me wonder why the concept of a Trinity is taught as truth?
- There would have to be three separate persons as is taught about the Trinity, but God the Father is the Holy Ghost!
- There isn't three...
- The Father and the Holy Spirit are the same Spirit which is God.

What is the Trinity?

- Matthew 28:19 is one of the “proof texts” that proves there is a Trinity.
- I studied this out because I first learned the identity of Jesus Christ and came to understand the importance of baptism and why we are baptized.
- That knowledge is what prompted me to look at this scripture through a magnifying glass.
- So is there a “Trinity”?

What is the Trinity?

- The rest of the Bible does not perfectly line up with this scripture, and we have to use the whole Bible to determine what is truth.
- For example: Every record of baptism in the book of Acts shows that the Apostles obeyed His command by baptizing in the name of Jesus, or in the name of the Lord (Jesus).
- Would the Apostles have disobeyed Him? God forbid! Think about this. There is NO WAY that the Apostles would have disobeyed Jesus.

What is the Trinity?

- *Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.*
- *Acts 8:16 (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.)*
- *Acts 10:48 And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Then prayed they him to tarry certain days.*
- *Acts 19:5 When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.*

What is the Trinity?

- *Acts 22:16 And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.*
- *Rom 6:3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?*
- *Gal 3:27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.*
- *Col 2:12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.*
- *1 Peter 3:21 The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:*

What is the Trinity?

- The second test:
- Did "they", the interpreters of the Bible back in the first few centuries, change it to agree with what they believed?
- Like 1 John 5:7, where it is common knowledge that words were inserted that were not in the original text, did they insert words to make the scripture agree with what they thought was true?

These words are all listed with a definition number of 9999. Look at the bottom right side where it shows that a 9999 is an inserted word.

NT:5101a Titios (tit'-ee-ohs); a variation of Titos ("Titus" See [NT:5103](#)); found only in [Acts 18:7](#); a man in Corinth whose surname was Justus; the Textus Receptus has only Ioustou: Titius.

NT:5143a tremā (tray'-mah); found only in [Matt 19:24](#); the eye (of a needle), a hole, an opening.

NT:5178a tupikos (toop-ee-kos'); an adverb related to [NT:5179](#); found only in [1 Cor 10:11](#): as a warning, by way of example, typologically (i.e. figuratively, as a prophetic type, a typological interpretation of Scripture).

NT:5240a huperekperissou. (hoop-er-ek-per-ees-soo'); See [NT:5228](#) and [NT:1537](#) and [NT:4053](#).

NT:5240b huperperisseuo (hoop-er-per-ees-soo'-o); from [NT:5228](#) and [NT:4052](#): to cause someone to overflow with something, to be present in (greater) abundance.

NT:5244a huperlian. (hoop-er-lee'-an); See [NT:5228](#) and [NT:3029](#): beyond measure, exceedingly.

NT:5274a hupoleimma (hoop-ol'-im-mah) or hupolimma (hoop-ol'-eem-mah) (as Westcott and Hort have it); from [NT:5295](#) and [NT:3005](#); found only in [Rom 9:27](#): a remnant.

NT:5620a otarion (o-tar'-ee-ohn); found only in [John 18:10](#): the (outer) ear, a handle.

NT:9999 NOTE: inserted word (x); This word was added by the translators for better readability in the English. There is no actual word in the Greek text. The word may be displayed in italics, or in parentheses or other brackets. to indicate that it is not in the original

What is the Trinity?

- These facts prove that the original Matthew 28:19 did not say, "in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Ghost", but in fact lines up with the rest of the scriptures very well with the words, "in My name".
- Since we know that words were inserted in 1 John 5, it's a short step to understand that these words were also inserted into Matthew 28 as well.

What is the Trinity?

- *Matt 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.*
- *19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in My name:*
- *20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen.*

What is the Trinity?

- So based on scripture:
 - We don't have “three” in the scriptures.
 - The Holy Spirit is the Father
 - Jesus is the body God made for Himself
 - Jesus is also the Father because the Spirit dwells within Him
 - Not by measure, like we have of the Spirit
 - The fullness of the Godhead dwells within Him bodily.
 - There's only one. His name is Jesus.
